"For the children." That is often the response of anyone who serves in Thieu Nhi. Many of us have dedicated countless years, possibly even a majority of our lives in service to children. I have always been moved by not only the spirit but the truth that lies in childhood. I have found that my purest moments of witnessing Christ in action are when I am with cac em. It is found in the wonder of learning about the 7 days of creation for the first time or having a burning question finally be

answered, or understanding at a deeper level the meaning behind the Holy Triduum. Too often we take for granted the blessing that is the children who surround us. They represent the legacy that carries on well after we have finished our own time here on earth. They themselves have so much to share. When was the last time you allowed them to share those gifts?

Pope Francis's intention this month to me also calls to mind the children of the Ukrainian war. It can not be ignored that war still rages in the year 2022. Battles fought over resources, land, ideologies and the like have marked countless lives. I cannot fathom the terror, sorrow, and possibly even anger of these children whose lives have been changed forever. It is easy to forget the impacts of war when it does not land at our own doorstep. To recap, the Ukrainian war has been raging since the escalation of the invasion in February of this year. Since then, deaths have risen to 38,000 and approximately 14 million people have been displaced. Coming from a history of displaced people due to war, we can begin to understand the realities the people of Ukraine face but let us think especially of the children. These children were living their lives as children, going to school, hanging out with friends, and eating dinner with their families when one day they were forced to immediately leave everything and everyone they've known for fear of imminent death. No person let alone a child should have to suffer that turmoil. God teaches us that children are the ones to inherit the kingdom of heaven and that they are the gifts He has bestowed onto us in this realm. I pray that the children of Ukraine find peace, hope, love, and the embrace of their families near and far to be able to endure such a tragedy.

This month I am also thinking of the childhood of our parents, the childhoods that run in our veins. Many of our parents and grandparents did not have the childhoods we have or are experiencing. Many of them sacrificed, suffered, hoped, and prayed for a better life for their own children. It makes me wonder how often we appreciate the childhoods we have been blessed with. While not all of us had or are going through easy childhoods and we each face our own unique set of challenges, we have in our power to ensure a safer, more beautiful world for the children to come. For myself, I have tons of fond memories of my younger years in Thieu Nhi with all the field trips, Christmas parties, dance practices and class projects. We should reflect on the sacrifices that made those memories possible and then we should work to ensure the next generation of children have the opportunity to create even more wondrous memories. That is how we show Christ's love.

A child does not ask to be born into this life therefore there is an inherent responsibility of those around that child to nurture, raise, support, and love that child as God loves all of His children. As members of Thieu Nhi Thanh The, we swear an oath to lead and guide the children inside our movement. We guide them to live lives of holiness so that they may shine for others and be the beacon of God's love. Not all children are blessed with this kind of care but yet our responsibility extends to those children as well. Ask yourself what is your responsibility to the next generation. Who raised you to be where you are today? What moments of impact as a child have stayed with you? Children were not made to suffer, they were made to thrive and be loved. That is my hope and prayer for all the children of the world. We all were once children and it was through the pouring out of countless blessings and teachings that molded us into a position to care for the next generation of children. Let us continue to serve with our whole hearts and create all opportunities we can for the children of this world.

Subject: VEYM 2022-2023 Training Camp Scholarships

Dearest Chaplains, Chaplain Assistants, Youth Leader Trainers, and Youth Leaders:

In an effort to increase awareness that Christ calls each Vietnamese Eucharistic Youth Movement (VEYM) Youth Leader to a life of service, at the same time, to further the VEYM's mission in cultivating servant leaders, the National Executive Committee is pleased to offer the following scholarships to support Youth Leaders and aspiring Youth Leaders who are examples of servant leader for the good of others.

1. ELIGIBILITY: The VEYM Servant Leader Training Camp/Convention Scholarship is open to any adult VEYM member (18 years and older) in active status and in good standing for at least one year at the time of application submission. The Chapter in which the applicant identifies with must also be in full compliance with VEYM's policies and guidelines.

2. SCHOLARSHIP PRIZES: Twenty (20) prizes total.

- *10X \$150.00 VEYM Youth Leader Training Camp, Level I
- *5X \$200.00 VEYM Youth Leader Training Camp, Level II
- *3X \$250.00 VEYM Servant Leader Training Camp, Level III
- *2X \$300.00 VEYM Youth Leader Trainer Level II Training Camp

Each scholarship prize will be in the form of a check or Zelle payment made payable to the winner AND presented to the winner at the training camp registered. Winners must be present to receive scholarship prizes. Scholarship prizes must be dispersed in 2023.

3. HOW TO ENTER: Beginning October 30th 2022, submit a complete scholarship application no later than December 30th, 2022 at 11:59 pm Eastern Time. Limit one (1) application per person. Application must include:

a. VEYM Servant Leader Resume (to include all relevant VEYM service, roles and experiences).
b. A short original, previously unpublished written response to the scholarship question, "As servant leaders in the VEYM, you are called to change hearts, heal divisions, and build community through virtues such as courage, humility, foresight, empathy, and stewardship. How has your Chapter and faith community grow as a direct result of your servant leadership?" Response must also include a brief statement indicating the scholarship category applied for. Response must not exceed two pages, be single spaced, 1-inch margin, and 10-pt Times News Roman font.

c. Two (2) letters of recommendation. One must be from your affiliated Chapter President with concurrence from your Chapter Chaplain. The second letter can be from any other VEYM members. The letters must attest to evidence of your servant leadership qualities and impact on the Chapter.

Please scan and send the application package to the National Executive Committee at headquarters@veym.net. 4. SELECTION OF POTENTIAL WINNERS: The National Executive Committee will convene a panel of judges to review all applications by the due date. Criteria will be based on the above requirements. The winners will be notified by e-mail on the 1st of the Lunar New Year.

5. OWNERSHIP: By submitting an application, the applicant acknowledges and agrees that: (a) VEYM will own the applicant's application, including written response submission and all publishing rights. Each applicant hereby irrevocably grants, transfers, sells, assigns and conveys to the VEYM, its successors and assigns, all present and future right, title and interest of every kind and nature whatsoever, including, without limitation, all copyrights, and all rights incidental, subsidiary, ancillary or allied thereto (including, without limitation, all derivative rights) in and to the application and the written response submission(s) for exploitation throughout the universe, in perpetuity, by means of any and all media and devices whether now known or hereafter devised (the "Rights"). The VEYM shall have the right, in its sole discretion, to edit, composite, morph, scan, duplicate, or alter, the Application and written response submission(s) for any purpose which Sponsor deems necessary or desirable, and each applicant irrevocably waives any and all so-called moral rights they may have in the application and written response submission(s) submitted by him or her. Each applicant hereby acknowledges that such applicant does not reserve any rights in and to the application and the written response submissions.

By entering the scholarship, each applicant acknowledges and agrees that the VEYM, its related affiliates, and each such company's respective employees, officers, directors and agents are not responsible for any costs, injuries, losses, or damages of any kind arising from or in connection with: (i) incomplete, lost, late, misdirected or illegible entries or for failure to receive applications due to any cause, including without limitation human, transmission, or technical problems, failures, or malfunctions of any kind, whether originating with sender, or otherwise, that may limit an applicant's ability to participate in the scholarship; or (ii) any injury or damage resulting, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, from participation in the scholarship and/or the use of any prize, including, without limitation, claims, costs, injuries, losses and damages related to personal injuries, death, damage to, loss or destruction of property, or any claims, costs, injuries, losses, or damages related to or based on the Applicant's rights of publicity or privacy, or the applicant's claim that he or she has somehow been defamed or portrayed in a false light. As such, the Vũ Khiêm Cung scholarship is intended to motivate, encourage, and provide financial assistance to one Eucharistic Youth Leader annually who exemplifies above and beyond qualities that can contribute to the ever-growing legacy of Rev. Vũ Khiêm Cung.

1) Type and submit an essay (no more than 2000 words English or Vietnamese) stating:

- Your reason for applying to this scholarship
- Your goals as a VEYM member
- Your source of motivation as a VEYM member
- This year the Catholic Church of the United States enters into the Eucharistic Revival campaign
 (<u>www.eucharisticrevival.org</u>). In reflection of the mission and goals of this campaign describe your own current
 relationship to the Eucharist and speak on the ways in which your role in VEYM has and/or will contribute to your
 developing relationship with Jesus in the Eucharist. In developing your relationship, how will you bring the youth
 to Jesus in the Eucharist.
 - Please include your saint name, full name, chapter name, phone number, and email on the header or footnote of every page.
- Submit a copy of an official academic transcript from your educational institution (if applicable). Unofficial watermarked transcripts may be submitted if an official transcript cannot be obtained.
- Submit two letters of recommendations from individuals who can speak to your qualities (one must be from a Eucharistic Youth Leader or Chaplain; letter cannot be from a family member).
- Submit a verification letter of "good standing" and "3 years of VEYM involvement" with signatures from the Chapter's President and Chaplain. Appendix A form may be used as verification of "good standing".
- 5) Submit all required documentations to VKC Scholarship Form
