
Throughout the last two thousand-plus years, the Catholic Church has been an influential force in society, with many of its members often driven by a strong sense of mission and purpose. Due to this charisma, many of these members have formed sanctioned groups and movements within the Church that allow others to connect and grow in faith, contributing to how influential the Church has been. Around the world, hundreds of these organizations serve the Church and provide services to the communities in which they reside.

Some of these groups are religious orders, such as those of the Salesians, Franciscans, and the Missionaries of Charity. But of

course, these groups are not limited to those who've consecrated their lives to God. There are groups for the Catholic laity as well. You might recognize some well-known examples of these organizations: the Knights of Columbus, the Catholic Youth Organization, the Legion of Mary, and even our very own Vietnamese Eucharistic Youth Movement.

Each of these groups has unique focuses and methods of operation, but they all ultimately seek one common, overarching goal for their members. To elaborate further, let's compare three of the example organizations previously mentioned. Our beloved VEYM focuses on the youth and training them to become well-rounded individuals in society and be ideal Christians. The Knights of Columbus is a fraternal organization dedicated to doing good in service to God and their neighbors. The Missionaries of Charity is an order of religious sisters who show God's love by serving and caring for the poor.

With these three examples, it is clear that each focuses very distinct - one directs its energy towards the youth, another towards fraternity among Catholic men, and the last towards caring for the poor. All three do different things and function very differently, yet all three work towards one united goal - to love God above all else and to love our neighbors as we love ourselves. In a sense, since we are united in mindset but function very differently, it is reminiscent of what Paul wrote to the Romans: "For as in one body we have many parts, and all the parts do not have the same function, so we, though many, are one body in Christ and individually parts of one another. Since we have gifts that differ according to the grace given to us, let us exercise them." With this in mind, we must remember to pray with the Pope this month for all of these groups and movements that they may share and exercise their charisms, or gifts from God, not primarily for themselves but for the benefit of others so that others can experience God's love through these groups.


